What is the Entrepreneurial Skills Pass?



The Entrepreneurial Skills Pass (ESP) is an international certification that proves students have had an entrepreneurship experience and have the necessary **knowledge, skills** and **competences** to start a business or be successfully employed.

What does the ESP show us?

Work skills - 90% of the ESP participants reported progression in at least one entrepreneurial competence, namely creativity, self-confidence and resourcefulness.

Job creation - 60% of students would consider self-employment as a career option.

Societal impact - JA alumni find jobs within 4 months after graduation, while those who have not had the same opportunity need 11 months or more to find a job.
